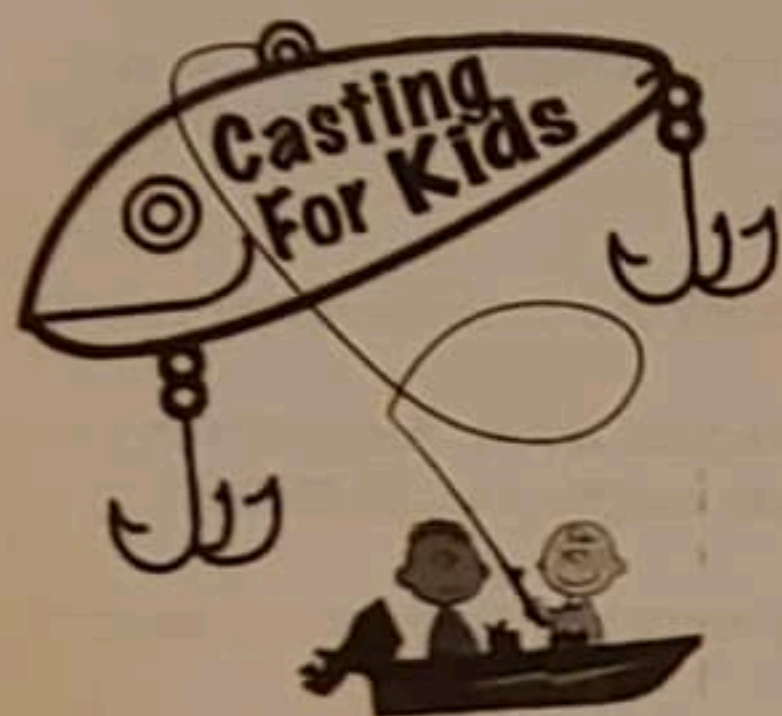

2021 TOURNAMENT RULES

1. OFF LIMITS: There will be no off-limits period.
 2. LIMIT: 5 bass – 12" length minimum mouth closed any way tail crosses the line.
 3. WEIGHT: Will be determined by total weight of all five fish. Largest fish weighed separately for big bass pot.
 4. TIES: Will be broken by largest bass and then coin toss if still not determined.
 5. PENALTY: 8oz. penalty per each dead fish weighed. Big bass must be alive to be eligible for big bass pot.
 6. FISHING METHODS: Only artificial lures are permitted. No live bait allowed. Trolling as a means to catch fish is prohibited.
 7. CHECK-IN: Teams must check in at least 30 minutes prior to safe daylight and must be in the immediate area of boat landing and off plane by 3 pm or be disqualified. NO EXCEPTIONS!
 8. BLAST OFF: Tournament director will determine safe daylight.
 9. BOAT OPERATOR: Must be at least 18 years of age.
 10. BOAT CHECK: Tournament director may, at his discretion, check the contents of any boat's livewell at any time prior to the start of the tournament.
 11. DRUGS AND ALCOHOL: Are strictly prohibited during tournament hours. Alcohol may be consumed once boat is removed from the water and the team has weighed in.
 12. PROTESTS: All decisions of the tournament director are final.
 13. LIFEJACKETS: Coast Guard approved life preserver must be worn any time the big motor is running.
 14. CULLING: Fish must be culled as they are caught. No culling at the weigh in site.
 15. FISH CARE: All boats must have a functioning livewell capable of keeping a 5 bass limit alive.
1. LIABILITY RELEASE: In signing this agreement, I hereby release Casting For Kids, all tournament officials, workers of the tournament, official launch site marinas and all sponsors from all damages, claims, demands, cost or expenses relating to injury or any persons or damage to any property which I may sustain or which I may cause by reasons of participation in or in connection with this tournament.
 2. COVENANT NOT TO SUE AND WAIVER OF SUBROGATION: I further agree I will never sue for damages on account of injury or damage I suffer or cause whether known now or which may develop in the future in connection with this tournament. In the event the tournament or the Tournament Director is sued because of my action, I expressly agree to indemnify and hold said Director harmless from any liability whatsoever, including court costs and attorney's fees, arising with respect to such actions. I understand that in waiving my rights to sue the Tournament Director I also am waiving the rights to recover from the Tournament Director or my insurance carrier from any claims they may pay on my behalf. I further understand that by signing this agreement, I waive any rights that my heirs or relatives have or may have to sue the Tournament Director for liability.
 3. I further agree to take a PSE and/or Polygraph test if required to do so and I understand that I must pass this test before any awards can be accepted. I agree to abide by the results of the examiner.
 4. I further agree that the director reserves the right to refund this entrance fee if he so chooses for any reason. I have acquainted myself with the rules and agree to abide by them.
 5. I signify by my signature below that I have read and understand the agreements numbered 1,2,3 and 4 above.
